BRIEF HISTORY

- Funder's Coalition initial convening was the result of the 2004 hurricanes season that impact the communities of Palm Beach and Martin Counties
- Group reconvened prior to the start of the 2017 to established a more coordinated funding process.
- Over 1.4 million dollars awarded to 76 organizations post Hurricane Irma



AVAILABLE FUNDING

Available funding resources will vary by grantmaking organizations















GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Nonprofit organization serving Palm
 Beach and/or Martin County residents
- Funding request must be a result of the named disaster



FUNDING PRIORITIES

- Emergency food
- Shelter
- Basic Needs
- Facility cost (repairs and relocation)
- Request to expand service capacity due to increase demand as a result of disaster



APPLICATION PROCESS

- Universal Application
- Apply through Community Foundation's Online application portal, Foundant
- Funders have access to all submitted applications
- Funding will be made from each respective funder
- Grantees timeframe and requirements may vary by funder
