# BRIEF HISTORY

- **Funder's Coalition initial convening was the result of the 2004 hurricanes season that impact the communities of Palm Beach and Martin Counties**
- **Group reconvened prior to the start of the 2017 to established a more coordinated funding process.**
- **Over 1.4 million dollars awarded to 76 organizations post Hurricane Irma**

# GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- **Nonprofit organization serving Palm Beach and/or Martin County residents**
- **Funding request must be a result of the named disaster**

# FUNDING PRIORITIES

- **Emergency food**
- **Shelter**
- **Basic Needs**
- **Facility cost (repairs and relocation)**
- **Request to expand service capacity due to increase demand as a result of disaster**



# APPLICATION PROCESS

- **Universal Application**
- **Apply through Community Foundation's Online application portal, Foundant**
- **Funders have access to all submitted applications**
- **Funding will be made from each respective funder**
- **Grantees timeframe and requirements may vary by funder**
